

# 3 Day Gunnison River Canoe Trip Information

The Gunnison River located between the towns of Delta and Grand Junction, offers a very scenic and classic western canyon river trip ideally suited for canoeing. The river flows through beautiful slickrock canyon country interspersed with small ranches and fruit orchards. Cottonwood stands in the area hold great blue heron rookeries and the area is an April breeding ground for Canada Geese. These cottonwoods are also home to peregrine falcons and bald eagles.

The deeper reaches of the canyon include part of the Dominguez Canyon Wilderness Study Area. This wilderness study area offers excellent opportunities for hiking, exploring and solitude. This area holds ancient Indian sites and petroglyphs. The Dominguez River (a tributary to the Gunnison River) cascades and falls through the side canyon dropping into several large swimming pools along the way. These pools can be accessed during an unforgettable side hike on day 2 of the trip.

This truly classic trip through the western plateau of Colorado has Class I-II water with several rapids and riffles making it both suitable and challenging for beginner and intermediate paddlers. The river has an average gradient of 7.3 feet per mile. All gear and food will be transported by the canoes.

The 3-day trip runs 37 miles and starts in Delta and ends in the town of Whitewater.

Menu is available upon request. All group equipment is provided except for sleeping bags and tents.
